Certificates of Sponsorship for Baptism and/or Confirmation:

If you wish to be a sponsor for Baptism and/or Confirmation, please note the following **REQUIREMENTS:**

- You **must** be a registered member at Immaculate
- You **must** be at least 16 years old
- You **must** have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist
- If married, you **must** have been married by a Roman Catholic Deacon or a Catholic priest,
- You **must be a practicing Catholic**, that is, you attend Mass and receive the Sacraments regularly.

If you meet these requirements, you may apply for a Certificate of Eligibility from us to be a sponsor for Baptism and/or Confirmation. You can request a certificate in person or have it mailed to you, after being signed by the Pastor.
